Yr 7-10 progress reports will be issued late next week. These reports describe how your child has progressed in the various subjects **reports** throughout the term.

The formatting of the *Yr 11-12 progress* reports (compressed subjects) have hit some snags. However, we will be able to send home a report before the holidays so you can see how your child has progressed so far. The final Preliminary course exams will be held in Wk 1, Term 2.

Wk 1 Term 2, Yr 11/12 will undertake Half Yearly Exams in Maths (assessable) and English. While the students should have some rest during the holidays, they need to spend time preparing for the exams. After the exams, the HSC courses in compressed subjects begin. I suggest parents look at the assessment schedules in the assessment handbook (a copy is on the school website), and that everyone is completely familiar with the rules of assessment tasks as outlined.

Taking place Week 2 and 3 next term, I strongly recommend parents make an appointment to discuss their child's progress.
